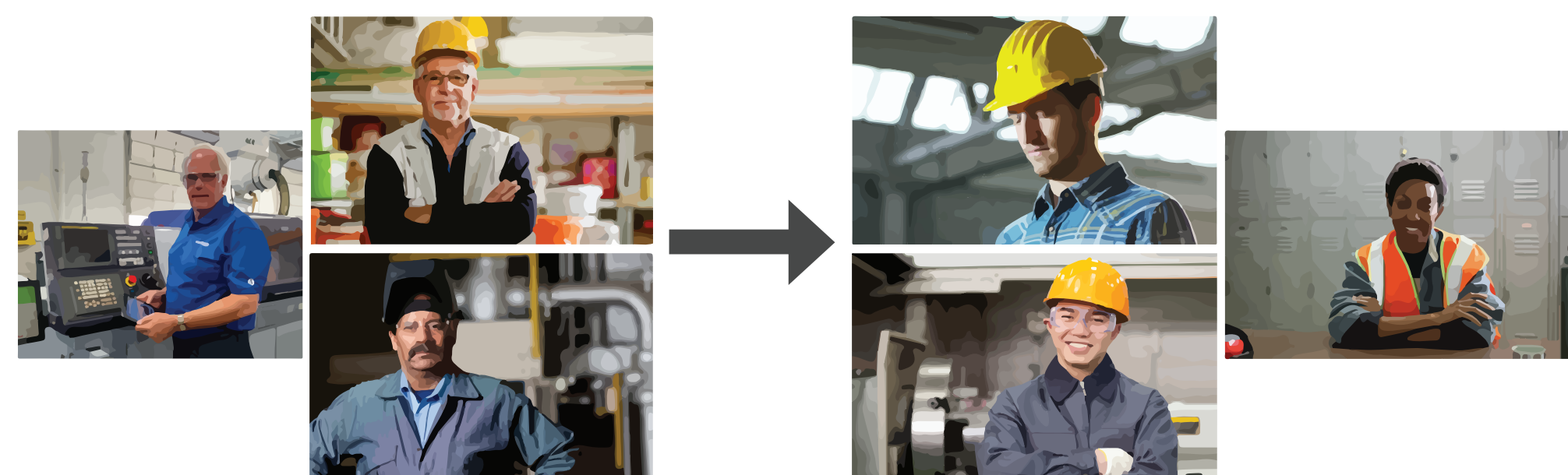


# Rockwell Automation Wearable Technology in Industrial Environments

Human-robot teams require a level of mutual awareness to operate safely. Communicating the state and intent of each party to the other is critical to ensuring continuous productivity.

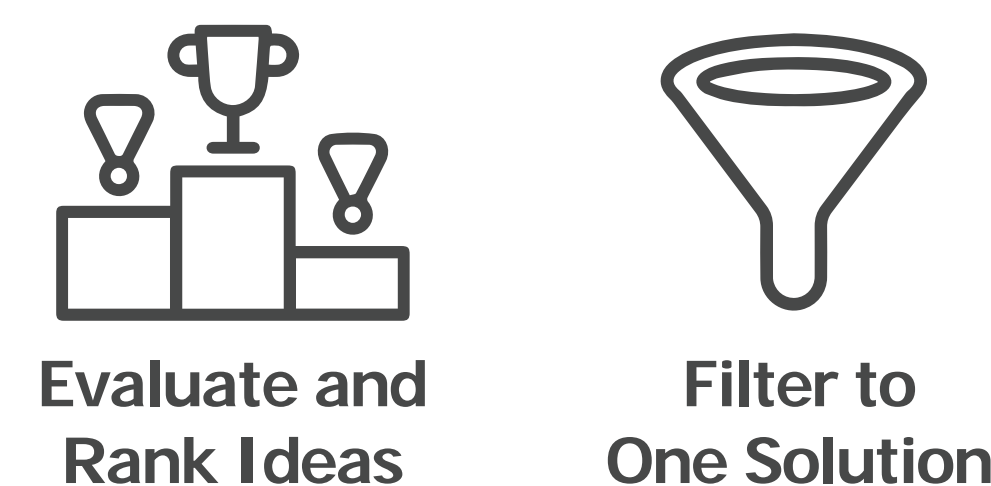
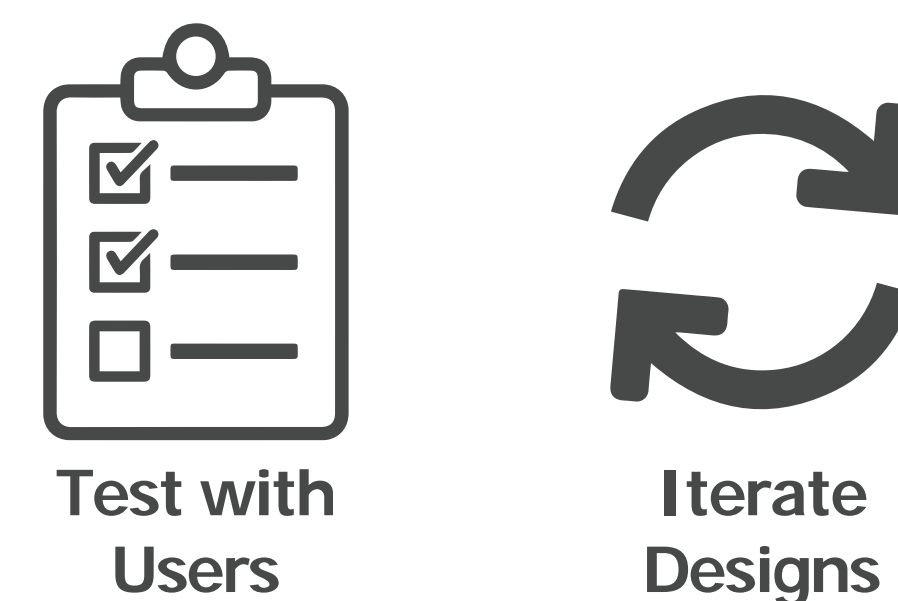
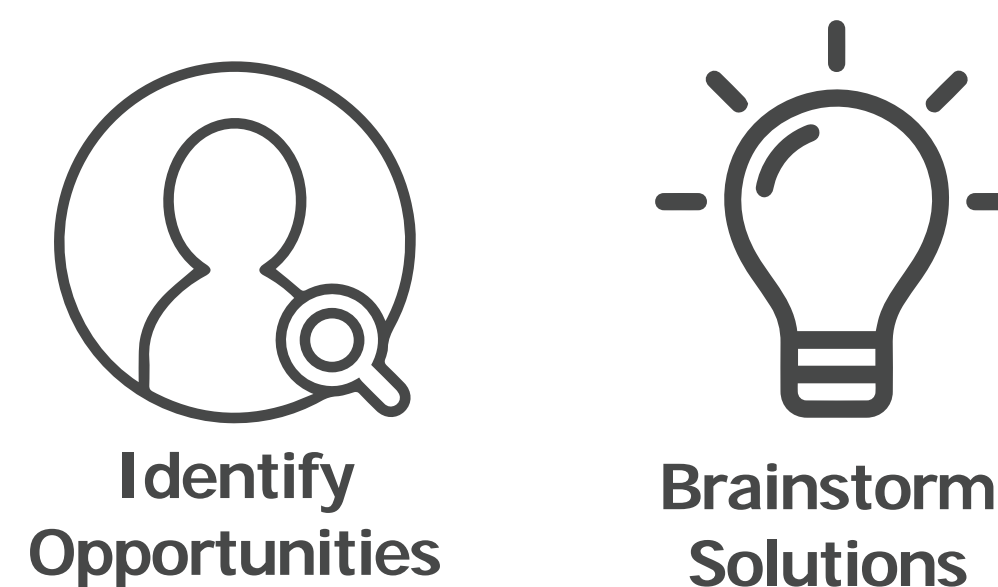
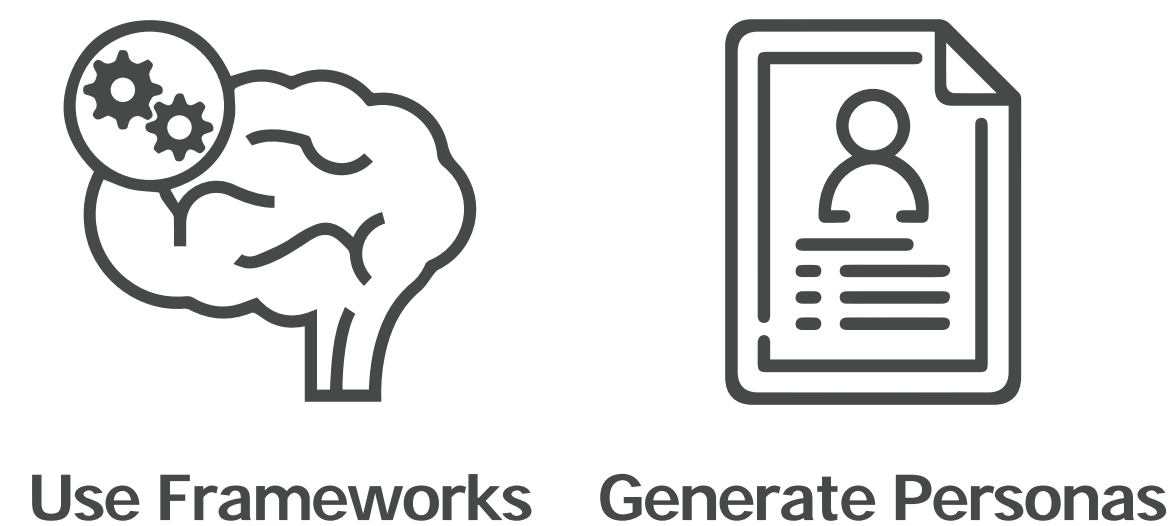
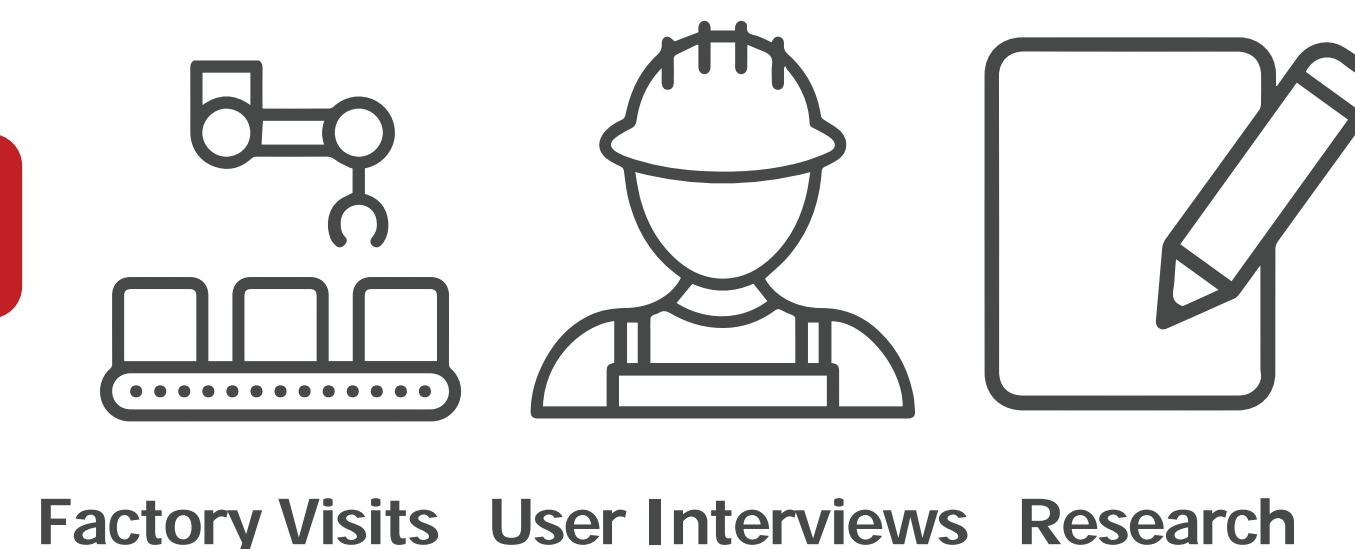
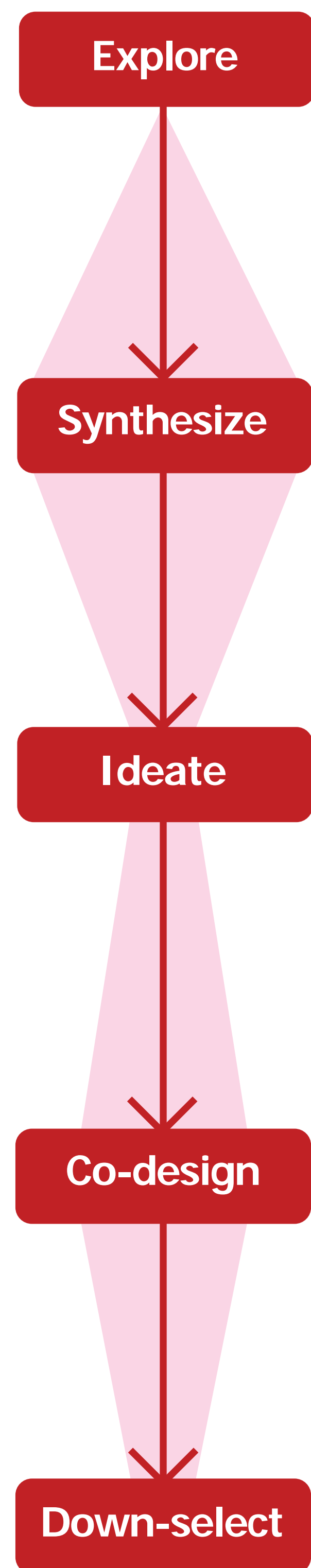


### TRUST

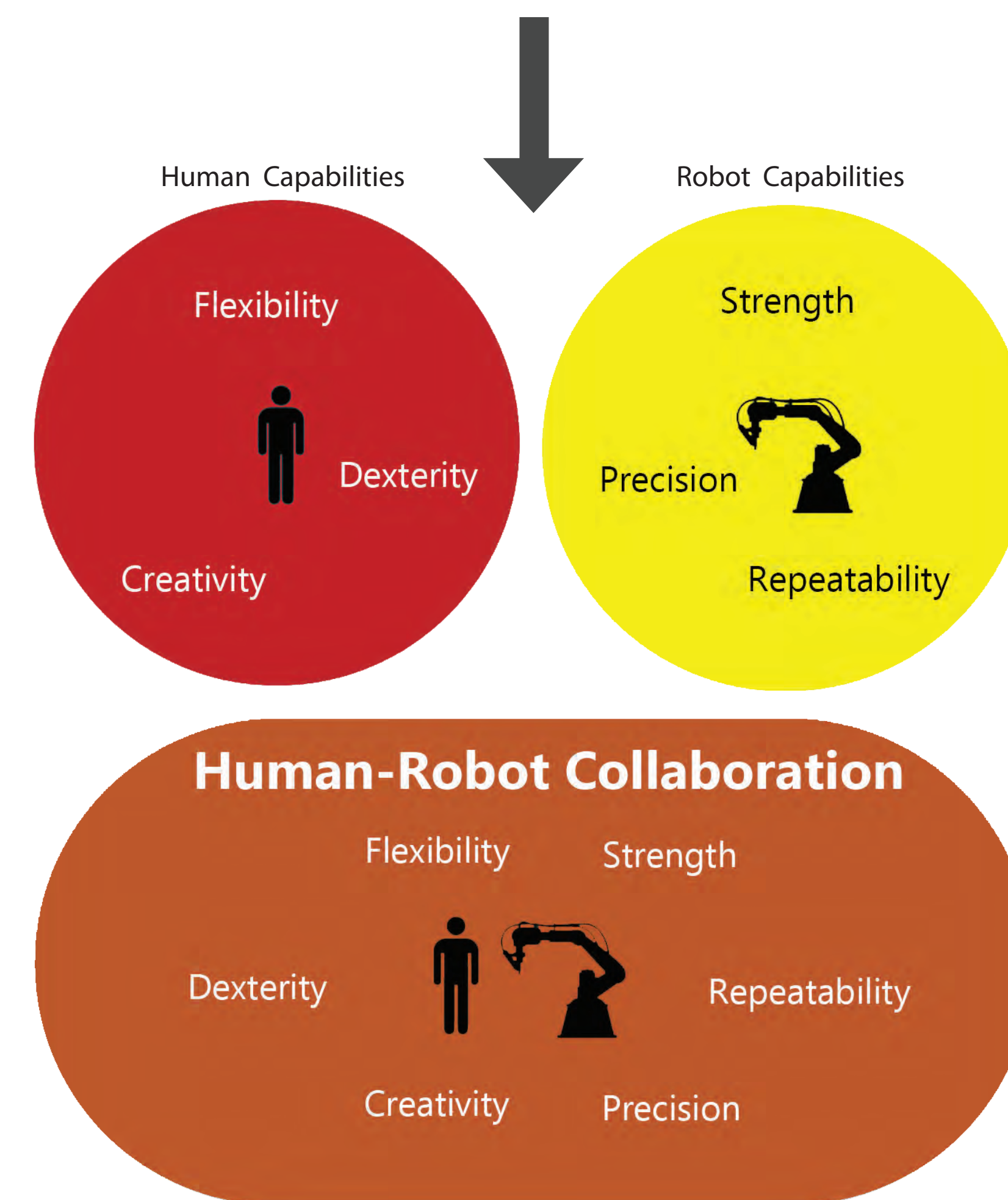
